Nago City, Okinawa Megasolar Power Plant Construction

Ichigo Group Holdings (“Ichigo”) launched its ECO energy business in November 2012 to contribute to a sustainable society by promoting renewable energy, including large-scale megasolar. Consistent with this goal, Ichigo ECO Energy has decided to build the Ichigo ECO Nago Futami megasolar power plant. All electricity produced by the plant will be sold to the Okinawa Electric Power Company.

Ichigo ECO Energy will continue to work to create a more sustainable society and aims to build its other planned megasolar power plants as quickly as possible.
