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Opening of Ichigo's Fourth <u>THE KNOT</u> Boutique Hotel THE KNOT HIROSHIMA

Ichigo is opening its fourth THE KNOT boutique hotel, THE KNOT HIROSHIMA, on December 10, 2020, near the Peace Memorial Park on Heiwa Odori.



Ichigo introduced THE KNOT, a new class of boutique hotels in 2017, consistent with its mission to preserve and improve real estate. Ichigo's THE KNOT is positioned between Japan's luxury hotels and budget hotels and represents a new form of accommodation for Japanese and global tourists in Japan.

THE KNOT HIROSHIMA, Ichigo's fourth THE KNOT hotel, is a joint project between Ichigo, Toa Jisho, and Genba Kanri Systems. The guest rooms were launched on August 1, 2020, and the all-day dining restaurant, MORETHAN, is being launched on December 10, 2020, marking the grand opening of the hotel.

THE KNOT aims to create and provide facilities and services that are not bound by

traditions within the hotel industry in an era where workstyle, traveling trends, and the definition of happiness are drastically changing. Under the philosophy of "Untitled," THE KNOT HIROSHIMA collaborated with local companies and artists in Hiroshima to create the interior, furniture, art, amenities, and services. The hotel captures the essence of Hiroshima and aims to promote the local culture.

The hotel has 201 guest rooms, primarily moderate twin-bed rooms $(25m^2)$ capable of accommodating the diverse needs of leisure and business travelers, with the lobby on the 14th floor overlooking the Peace Memorial Park. MORETHAN, the all-day dining restaurant, is located on the first floor. Kei, the rooftop bar, features seasonal local spirits, including sake, shochu, and craft beers.

1. Design Concept

2. Public Area

A space that transforms from a place to enjoy a refreshing morning to a place to enjoy some music and drinks at night. The public area includes the rooftop bar and front desk, and was designed as a place for locals and visitors to connect, with an emphasis on the lighting and high ceilings. Showcasing local materials such as Hiroshima wood and shells of Hiroshima oysters, the space evokes the concept of HIROSHIMA LIVE-ING.



3. Guest Rooms

In contrast to the liveliness of the 14th floor, the warm gray of the guest room floors conveys a sense of calm. With a total of six room types, guest rooms are primarily twinbed rooms, double beds, and deluxe rooms, and the simple room design and muted

lights create a relaxing atmosphere. The lights in the guest rooms were made exclusively for the hotel.

4. Rooftop Bar and Restaurant Kei

Add some luxury to everyday life. Rooftop Bar Kei on the 14th floor features a great view of the city, nice music, and carefully selected drinks, including seasonal Japanese sake from Hiroshima and the Chugoku region.



5. All-Day Dining MORETHAN



MORETHAN offers all-day dining from breakfast to dinner. The restaurant features fresh prosciutto, oven-baked pizza, charcoal-grilled dishes, pasta, and natural wines. MORETHAN is a place where people can casually gather with friends, family, and colleagues.



6. City Guide Desk and Artwork


