For its new office, Spice Factory will utilize the "Sustainable Platform," a service that enables the selection and purchase of reusable, environmentally friendly, ethical materials that promote a circular economy. In addition to reusing construction materials from the World Expo 2025 in Osaka, the building will also actively use ethical materials. Specifically, it will leverage the official reuse framework "Expo Circular Market Myaku-ichi!" promoted by the World Expo 2025 in Osaka, as well as Matinno, operated by NewNormDesign Inc., a platform specializing in the use of sustainable building materials. The building's planning and design will be overseen by sustainable architecture designer Fara Taraie.




