Ichigo Receives RE100 Certification

Ichigo is a Japanese sustainable infrastructure company dedicated to making the world more sustainable. Ichigo believes companies exist to serve society, and is committed to contributing to a sustainable society while growing long-term value for its shareholders.

As part of joining RE100, a global initiative, Ichigo achieved 100% renewable electricity and received its RE100 certification.

Ichigo completed sourcing 100% renewable electricity across its operations (excluding assets sold, expected to be sold, and for which Ichigo does not have authority for energy management) in August 2024, excluding electricity generated by in-house cogeneration (0.1%), and received its RE100 certification following a review of its actual energy usage during the one-year period from September 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025. As a result, Ichigo achieved its Ichigo 2030 vision KPI of 100% renewable energy across all operations by 2025. Ichigo will continue to maintain its RE100 certification and contribute towards realizing a net zero carbon society.

RE100 is a global initiative bringing together the world's most influential businesses committed to 100% renewable power. Led by the Climate Group, they operate in a diverse range of sectors and send a powerful signal to policymakers and investors to accelerate the transition to a clean economy.
